Writer Guidelines

- Submissions must be **less than 500 words** of text (including narratives, poetry, musings) with images, or no more than half a page of photos, cartoons or other media *with captions* (We want to know what the image is about!). If only submitting text, roughly one page, single spaced.
- Please submit your pieces to <u>MOSAIC@grinnell.edu</u> in word, Times, 12 pt, and double-spaced. Please also suggest a title for your piece. Submit images in .png format, high resolution (300 ppi or more). WeTransfer.com is a free website to send images if they cannot be attached by email.
- Please be considerate of the diversity of our readers. We invite critical inquiry but not destructive messages toward/about others. If your submission is about a country or culture other than your own, we ask for it to be reviewed in collaboration with a person from or with expertise regarding that place.
- The MOSAIC Editor will review/revise submissions prior to publishing and we will contact you for approval if edits or changes are made.
- It is our practice to list the author's name, class year, and home country (or professional title), but writers may request for this information to be omitted.
- The MOSAIC Editor, in consultation with OISA staff, reserve the right to select or omit submissions for the publication.
