



Grinnell College Office of Admission Overnight Policy and Release Form

To arrange an overnight stay at Grinnell College, please contact the Office of Admission at least 10 days in advance. Once your overnight arrangements have been confirmed by the College, please read the Overnight Policy and complete the release form below. This form is required for all visiting students staying overnight on the Grinnell College campus. Completed Overnight Policy and Release forms may be submitted via mail, fax or email (see information at the bottom of the form.)

The Office of Admission must receive the completed two-page **Grinnell College Overnight Policy and Release Form** at **least 3 business days prior** to the scheduled overnight date. **You will not be permitted to stay overnight in on-campus housing without submission of the Overnight Policy and Release form prior to your arrival.**

For Students:

As a campus guest, Grinnell College requires that you assume the same responsibility for your actions that Grinnell students have assumed. Please read the following statement and sign your name to indicate that you understand the statement. If you do not understand the statement or how it applies to you, please ask a member of the Admission staff to explain it to you before you sign:

I am aware that although Grinnell College has agreed to host me overnight, neither the Office of Admission nor any other office or personnel of Grinnell College will be supervising me during my on-campus stay. Visiting students, like enrolled students, are responsible for their behavior and are expected to behave as adults within the expectations described below.

I am aware that participants in on-campus visitation programs are required to abide by Federal and State laws, local municipal codes and the policies governing student conduct that all students enrolled at Grinnell College are expected to follow. I acknowledge that Iowa law prohibits the consumption of alcoholic beverages by persons under 21 years of age as well as all use of controlled substances.

Further, I understand that the Office of Admission will consider any negative behavior during my campus stay when reviewing my application for admission. My violation of any of the above laws, regulations, codes and/or any damage to Grinnell property may impact my application to Grinnell College.
