Have you logged in lately?

1. You may upload your resumes and cover letters to PioneerLink. Access them online from home or abroad.
2. The advanced search can customize results for your interests and save search criteria
3. The Search Agent function can be set to notify you when new jobs/internships with your search criteria are posted
4. The extended job search utilizes four aggregate search engines to find opportunities nationwide
5. The document library stores past CDO and InternConnection newsletters
6. The PioneerLink includes an 1500 employer addresses
7. Approximately 5 new jobs/internships are posted to PioneerLink each day
8. The 2009-10 CDO workshop schedule will be available and searchable via PioneerLink this fall
9. PioneerLink is more than jobs. Posts may include scholarship, volunteer, and research positions.
10. You may save employers and/or postings as "favorites" to check when you log in at a later date
