Caveat: If an individual is arrested for one or more types of law violations during a single incident only the arrest is counted not disciplinary action so there is not duplicate reporting.

Hate Crimes: In 2010 there were 15 total reportable incidents classified as hate crimes for the Grinnell College Campus.

(2) Incidents involving Intimidation, listed as racial bias and gender bias (residence halls).

(1) Incident of burglary involving sexual orientation bias (residence hall).

(11) Incidents of vandalism/destruction of property involving sexual orientation bias (on campus). One incident involved race bias.

(1) Incident of vandalism/destruction of property involving sexual orientation bias (public property-street).

As of 2009 the crimes of Larceny-theft, simple assault, intimidations and vandalism/destruction of property were added to the list of crimes that must be reported if a hate crime was involved.

Caveat: Conard Environmental Resource Areas (CERA) is located in Jasper County; site specific information did not reveal any statistical reportable crime incidents.
