ITEM ACTION

- 1.0 The Physics Department took exception to the characterization of the Physics Seminar Room as underutilized. They stated that the room is used quite often for non-scheduled departmental activities. H&R stated that if this were the case, it should be reclassified from a college shared to a departmental space.
- 2.0 Program space designation Ph 21 Faculty Research should be changed to Ph 05 c Modern Waves.
- 3.0 Program designations Ph 06 and Ph 07 should be relabeled Ph 05a and Ph 05b.
- 4.0 The following labs were identified as open non-scheduled spaces:
 - Optical/laser Lab- 9 student capacity
 - Nuclear Physics Lab- 10 student capacity.
 - Atomic Physics Lab- 12 student capacity
- 5.0 One additional faculty research lab needs to be added to the program.
- 6.0 Program space designation Ph 16a will contain an AFM (Atomic Force Microscope).
