

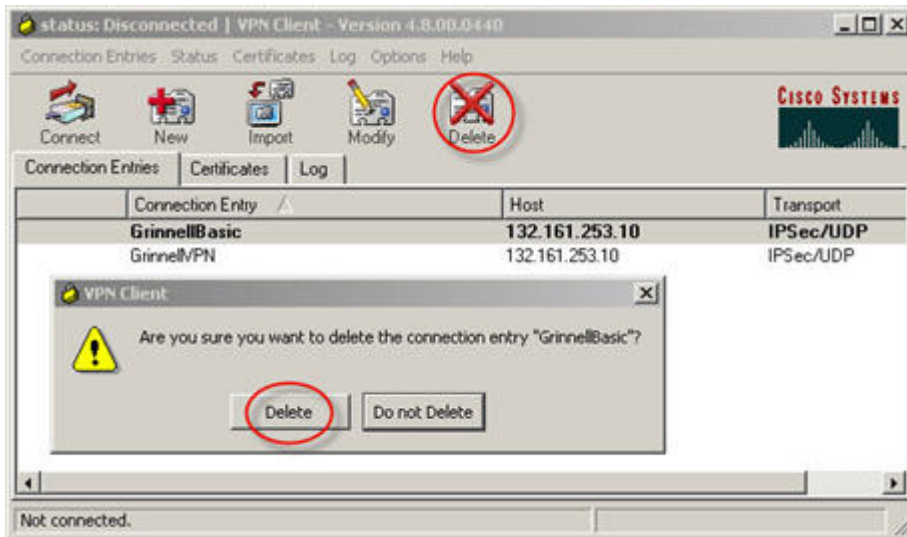
Grinnell College VPN access upgrade for Microsoft Windows.

Grinnell College's VPN (Virtual Private Network) is being upgraded. Consequently the VPN client software on your computer will need a new connection profile.

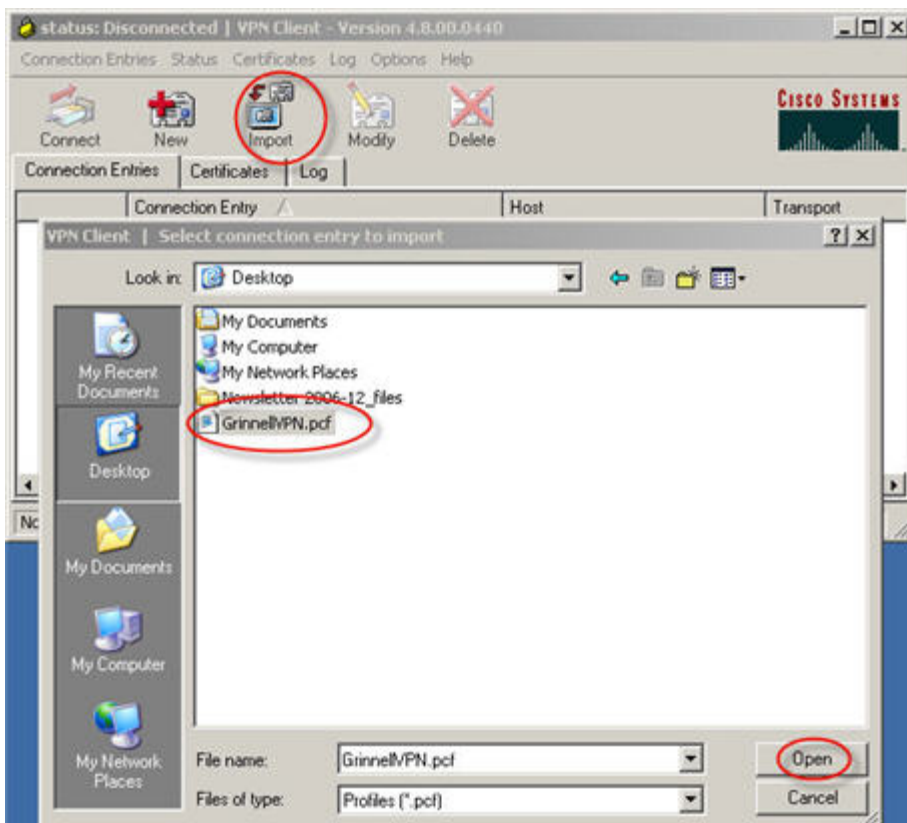
Please select one of the following appropriate options to update or install the VPN software on your computer.

1) Import a new connection profile.

- save the new connection profile "[GrinnellVPN.pcf](#)" to your computer. Remember the save directory.
- start Cisco VPN Client
- delete existing Grinnell profiles, GrinnellVPN and GrinnellBasic.

2) Install VPN client software.

If you would like to use VPN but do not have the client installed, follow installation instructions below.

- Save "[GC_vpnclient_setup.msi](#)" to local computer.
- Double click on .msi file and follow installation instructions.

3) Upgrade existing VPN client software.

This is not required to use the new VPN network.

- Save "[GC_vpnclient_setup.msi](#)" to local computer.
- Uninstall existing version; Start>Control Panel>Add/Remove Programs. Select and Remove "Cisco Systems VPN Client"
- Open Windows Explorer and browse to folder C:\Program Files\Cisco Systems. Delete folder VPN Client.
- Reboot
- Double click on .msi file and follow installation instructions.
