Yes, it might be true! *Grinnell Dining* is currently evaluating a Zero Trans Fat (ZTF) cake donut mix and ZTF donut frying shortening. If successful, these products will be replacing our current frying shortening (for donuts – all other fryers have used “ZTF” shortening for the past 2 years) and cake donut mix.

Grinnell Dining continues to evaluate new “ZTF” products as they become available. Additionally, we are in contact with a number of institutions that are also evaluating other new and exciting products that are not currently available in our area. As these new products evaluate well, we will work with our suppliers to bring them into stock.
