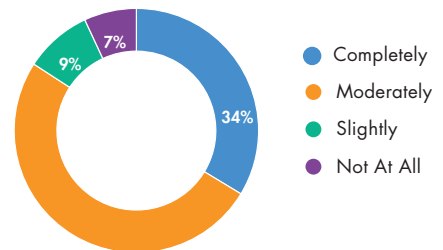

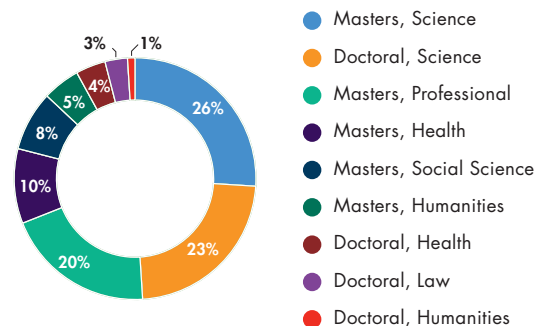


TOTAL COMPENSATION FOR EMPLOYED GRADUATES

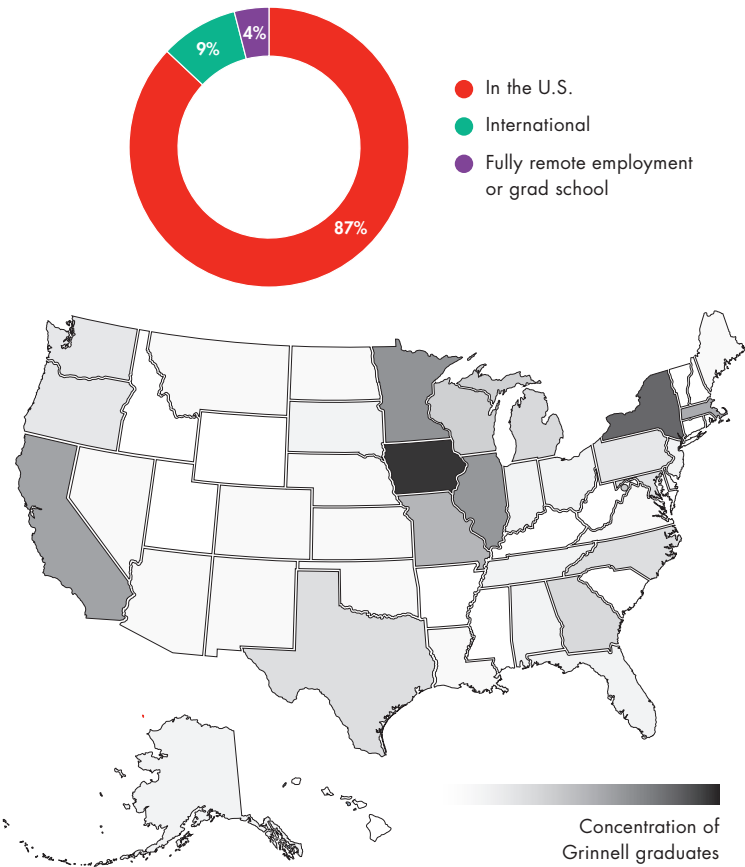


TYPES OF GRADUATE PROGRAMS

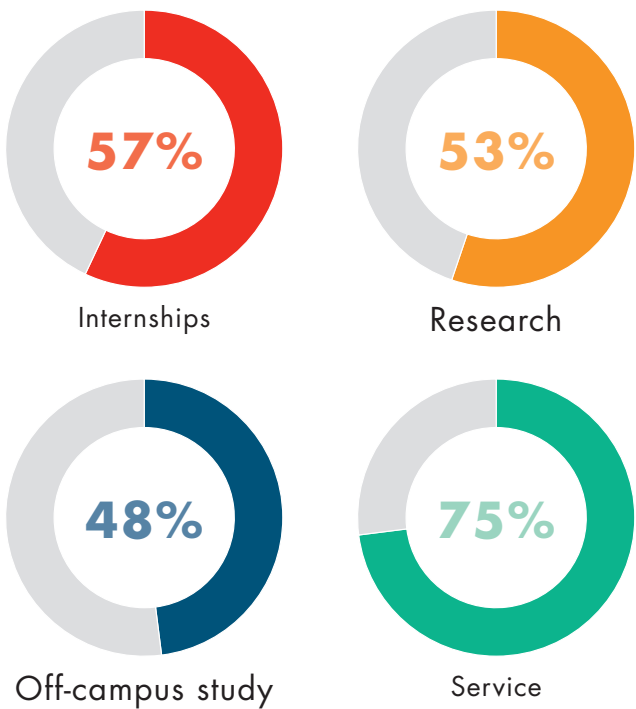
86% Accepted to at least one program
