
Title IX Protective and Supportive Measures At-A-Glance

Protective and Supportive Measures available to the Complainant, Respondent, and Witnesses include, but are not limited to

Protective Measures

- Facilitating a meeting with law enforcement to discuss safety planning and law enforcement options
- Limiting an individual's or organization's access to certain College facilities or activities pending resolution of the matter
- An interim restriction on residence hall access pending the outcome of a conduct proceeding
- An interim suspension, ban, or paid/unpaid leave pending the outcome of a conduct and/or criminal proceeding
- Interim restriction on student activities or representing the College in any capacity such as playing on an official team; serving in student government, performing in a musical or theatre production; or participating in a recognized student organization
- Providing a safety escort between classes, work, and other activities
- Campus No-Contact Order or No-Trespass Order
- Assistance in obtaining a civil protection order
- A change in student's College-owned residence
- Assistance navigating off campus housing concerns
- Assistance in completing residence relocation
- Any other protective measure that can be used to achieve the goals of this policy

Supportive Measures

- Coordinating access to medical and counseling services and assistance in setting up initial appointment, both on and off campus
- Coordinating rescheduling of exams and assignments
- Coordinating alternative course completion options
- Coordinating a change in class schedule or transferring sections, including the ability to drop a course without penalty
- Connection to academic support services, such as tutoring
- Connection to disability resources
- Suppression of directory information
- A change in work schedule, job assignment, and office/work space
- Assistance in resolving concerns about immigration status, visas or financial aid
- A voluntary leave of absence
- Any other remedy which can be tailored to the involved individuals to achieve the goals of this policy
