Module 3: Voting absentee by mail

As soon as you receive the absentee ballot (on or about Oct. 5th), VOTE. That means:

- indicate on the mail-in ballot which candidates you're voting for
- sign and date the ballot,
- mail it in to your <u>county election official</u> (the county auditor) ONLY. Again the mail is prepaid.

The reason to do all of this as quickly as you can, including voting by mail, is to ensure that intended slow downs in the postal service will not affect your vote. Neither will any intended backlogs at the polling place on election day.
