

Grinnell College Student Health and Wellness On-Campus COVID Testing Clinic Walk-Through

Things to Know/Do Before Testing

- You **MUST** wear a face mask and shield.
 - Pick up your PPE packet before coming to your first test.
 - A limited number of shields are available on-site if yours is misplaced or broken.
- You must **NOT** eat or drink anything at least 10 minutes prior to testing.
- Log into the portal to obtain QR code.

Portal Instructions

1. In a web browser, go to shacscm.grinnell.edu.
2. Enter your college email.
3. Hit **Next**.
4. Enter your college password.
5. Hit **Sign In**.
6. Enter your DUO confirmation.
You may have to manually go back to your browser.
7. Hit **Yes** or **No**. It doesn't matter.
8. Enter your birth date.
9. Hit **Proceed**.
10. You are now logged in!
You may need to click on the grey to see the landing page instead of the left navigation.
11. Click on **Show Barcode** located under your appointment time.
Do **NOT** click Show Badge. That is your **user** code and you need your **appointment** code.
12. The system will log you out after a while. We suggest taking a screenshot of the code. You can also print it off from a computer or take a picture of the computer screen with your phone.

Testing Clinic

- The Testing Clinic is located in the Natatorium Lobby at 1201 10th Avenue, Grinnell, IA. This is across the street from Harris Center.
- Use the North Entrance. The South Entrance is an exit only.
- Use the set of doors on the right side of the North Entrance.
- If you have been exposed, have any COVID symptoms, or don't feel good **DO NOT** go into the Natatorium. **Call SHAW at 641-269-3230**. You will be given instructions on how to be tested at the outdoor station.
- **Symptoms** – again, call SHAW at 641-269-3230 if you are experiencing any of these symptoms.
 - Fever/Chills
 - Muscle Aches

- Cough
- Sore Throat
- Vomiting or Diarrhea
- New Loss of Taste or Smell
- When you enter, the first station is to your left.
- There are 2 Check-in Stations. You can check-in at whichever one is available. Remember – keep your distance from others in line!
- Check-in Station
 - You must have your P-Card or another photo ID.
 - Hold your ID up to the window.
 - You will then be given a small sample cup with your name on it.
 - Remember, no food or drink 10 minutes before spitting.
 - Log into shacscom.grinnell.edu
- Start Spitting!
 - With your face shield on and your mask off, begin spitting into the cup.
 - You must cover the bottom of the cup. This usually takes about 5 spits.
 - If you are having trouble producing saliva, gently bite the sides of your tongue.
- Throughout the clinic there are red circles spaced 6 feet apart. Use these as guides as you keep your distance from those around you.
- At your first appointment, you will need to confirm your address and phone number. This is for the Iowa Department of Public Health in case of a positive test.
- Also at your first appointment, you will sign/submit your testing agreement. This is only done at your first test. This station is skipped at all future testing.
- Keep Spitting!
- There are multiple testing stations. Go to the first available.
- Place your specimen cup through the slot.
- Show your QR Code (on your phone) to the tester who will scan it.
- Wait while your specimen is prepped. The tester will let you know when you are ok to leave!
- You are done! Exit through the south doors.
- Results are received 24-36 hours after testing.
